SUBJECT: ODE Statement of Assurance

School districts are required to submit a Statement of Assurance Form to ODE each year. This form indicates compliance with the Oregon Administrative Rules in OAR 581-022. There are standards related to: School Improvement, Career Education, Drug and Alcohol Prevention, State Testing, Health Services, Kindergarten Programs, Standardization, District and School Performance Reports, Diploma Requirements, Equal Opportunity, District Curriculum, Talented and Gifted, Alternative Education, Emergency Plans, Guidance and Counseling, Instructional Materials, Records and Reports, and Personnel Policy.

Compliance with Oregon Administrative Rule 581-022 is established through the Continuous Improvement Plan (CIP). The District CIP has been reviewed and approved by ODE. To be in compliance, the Superintendent must provide the School Board with information that the District has met the requirements of OAR 581.022. This memorandum is verification of the District's compliance.
